Welcome to the Land Administration Standardisation Event: LADM 2017

Delft, The Netherlands, March 16 and 17 2017



It is our great pleasure to invite you to the Land Administration Standardisation Event 'The 6th LADM Workshop', which will be organised in Delft, The Netherlands, March 16 and 17, 2017. This is a joint initiative of the International Federation of Surveyors, the Global Land Tool Network, the Open Geospatial Consortium and the Technical Committee 211 on geographic Information of the International Standardisation Organisation. With support from the World Bank, UNGGIM and the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors.

The need for operational standards to support Land Administration is now widely recognised. They are critical for the initial acquisition of data on land rights globally and for the consistent maintenance of Land Administration information and the dissemination of data for a wide range of applications in all countries. As an example, during this workshop we will be look at the linking of Building Information Modelling and OGC standards such as CityGML, IndoorGML and LandInfra. This will include an overview of land tenure systems and logistics related to large scale data acquisitions which may be based on different approaches.

Collaboration and coordination is vital for continued innovation in the Land Administration Domain. It is important that representatives from different organisations get to know each other and know who is doing what in order to build synergy and avoid any unnecessary duplication of activities. Standardisation is key to enabling consistent global land administration. We would very much appreciate your participation in the workshop and invite you to join us.

Expected outcomes: a Draft Land Administration Standards Global Action Plan. Clarity on how to work together and on the roles and responsibilities in relation to a White Paper that will be developed as a first action. Sharing an overview of the Standards Landscape for Land Administration – ISO LADM, OGC CityGML, IndoorGML, LandInfra, etc, RICS Surveying, FIG/3D Cadastres, FIG/GLTN/WB Fit For Purpose Land Administration.
