Member association registration for voting

Eligible to vote are *member associations* (MA) in good standing. This official representative will receive the emails with the link to voting and will cast the vote on behalf of the association. This year there will be the election for two new FIG Vice Presidents. FIG Council has received five nominations. There will be up to four voting rounds; one or two rounds for the first candidate and again one or two rounds for the second.

We wish to remind Member Associations that only those who have paid all their arrears up to 31 December 2023 will be allowed to vote at the General Assembly. A list of Member Associations with arrears will be published on the agenda web site prior to the General Assembly.
