

REPORT ON THE YSN NIGERIA GLOBAL SURVEYORS' DAY AND OTHER ACTIVITIES (2nd FEBRUARY TO 18th. APRIL, 2023)

1. YSN NIGERIA PARTICIPATES IN GLOBAL SURVEYORS' DAY, 2023

Young Surveyors all over Nigeria celebrated Global Surveyors Day on the 21st of March, 2023. There were a series of activities by YSN members at national, zonal, and state branches. These activities included road walks, training, media talk, awareness about the profession to the public, etc. The YSN Nigeria organised a virtual seminar session which started at 3:05 pm and ended around 5:05 pm. The first session was on "Surveying as a corporate business: understanding business structuring and branding for Surveyors" delivered by Barrister Etido David where he talked about personal branding, how surveyors should make an impact on their society, value-added services, attending conferences, joining politics and advocacy programmes, etc. The second session was delivered by Surv. Dr. A.C. Chukwuocha who talked on "accomplishing good registration of GNSS Derived Coordinates on Existing Local Geospatial Data Infrastructure". We had more than 30 participants with Surv. Dr. Lola Olayinka, fnis and Surv. Hassan Elias, fnis, amongst other high dignitaries in attendance.



2. 2023 FIG WORKING WEEK AND FIG ARN ACTIVITIES

The FIG technical committee has accepted at least 5 manuscripts of our members for presentation at the upcoming 2023 FIG Working Week in Orlando. Our members are getting ready for visa interviews and other preparations necessary to attend the Working Week.

On the other hand, YSN Nigeria receives the schedule of 2023-2026 activities of FIG Africa Regional Network, from the Chairperson, FIG-ARN, Mohammed Mamman Kabir, mni. A few of these include: 4 No. Africa Young Surveyors Summer Camp and 3 No. ARN-FIG Mentoring/Train—The—Trainer Workshops.

3. YSN MEMBERS' ACHIEVEMENTS/RECOGNITION:

Surv. Adamu Bala, MNIS was selected by the famous American geospatial magazine – the xyHt as one of the 23 Young Geospatial Professionals to watch in 2023. He equally got recognised as one of the (under 40 years) Geospatial World 50 Rising Stars drawn from 34 countries worldwide, by the Geospatial World Forum.



4. SURCON INDUCTION, 2023

The Surveyors Council of Nigeria (SURCON) inducted 394 newly registered surveyors on the 16th of February, 2023. We are happy to announce that our members are getting more interested in Registering into different cadres of SURCON registration based on their level of qualification. This is evident in the increasingly large numbers of Young Surveyors getting Registered annually.







5. 2023 YSN ELECTION AND THE FIRST DRAFT OF CODE OF CONDUCT REVIEW

The tenure of current YSN Exco members elapses in a few months, therefore, there will be a change of YSN Exco members through elections coming up during the 57th NIS Conference. The electoral committee had been set up and inaugurated in November, 2022. They have since commenced their duties as ELCOM members.


The YSN Congress also reached a resolution to collect N3,000 annual dues from each member, to be shared as N2,100 (70%), N600 (20%), and N300 (10%) for State, National, and Zonal branches respectively.

The first draft of reviewed YSN Code of Conduct has also been released to the members on 28th March, 2023, to make observations and additional inputs. This will pave way for the final draft scheduled to be presented to the YSN congress during the upcoming 57th. NIS AGM/Conference.

6. ZONAL AND STATE CHAIRS REPORTS

SOUTHEAST ZONE

The Young Surveyors Network South East Zone is organizing a South East Survey Camp, 2023 titled "Harnessing the potentials of Young Surveyors", which is scheduled to hold on 17-18th May, 2023 at the NIS Imo State Complex, New Owerri, Imo State. Registration for the camp is ongoing at the cost of N5,000 per participant.





YSN DELTA STATE BRANCH

The Young Surveyors Network, Delta State (a Subgroup of Nigerian Institution of Surveyors) is going to host a 2-Day State Conference with a theme: Raising the 21st Century Surveyors, from 28-29th April, 2023. The venue is NUJ Hall by Marian Babangida Way, core Area Asaba. The conference features the Nomination of YSN Executives, the State's Surveyor General message to YSN Delta, AutoCAD Civil 3D for Route Profile & Layout Design Training, GNSS and COR Station, UAV/ Drone Training, Discussion on Local Content Courses in the Universities, etc.

YSN FCT BRANCH

The branch in collaboration with Oba surveys organized a Python training program, which began in December and came to a conclusion on the 10th of February 2023. The training was aimed at improving the programming skills of participants. The training program was conducted by an experienced trainer who provided both theoretical knowledge and practical exercises to reinforce the learning.

YSN LAGOS STATE BRANCH




