





# Governance: the rules of the game

- **Primary powers**
- **Primary institutions**
- **Strategic decision making**
- **Norms and values**



# Management: implementation for results

- **Planning**
- **Implementation and monitoring**
- **Achieving pre-defined results**
- **Transform available resources to achieve concrete outcomes.**



# Land Governance

- A. Good land stewardship
- B. Efficient land use
- C. Equitable land use

Typically a line ministry

**Not defined spatially or economically**



# Land Management

- Process oriented
- Administration of powers
- Efficiency in local use priorities
- Records
- Dispute resolution

**May be spatially or economically defined**



# Governance + management

- Governance must shape management
- Management should inform governance
- Management should not be a substitute for governance


**Principles and objectives should be in common even as means of achieving them may vary**



# E.g. Peri-urban development

- Neither urban nor rural
- Major contest between spatial, economic and cultural priorities
- Requires an outcome oriented framework

If the governance framework is clear, local management is more effective



# GLTN in the Urban-Rural Continuum


- Support land interventions in both urban and rural contexts
- Promote the continuum of land rights approach and Fit-for-Purpose Land Administration
- Strong network of both urban and rural land actors
- Develop and implement specific land tools to strengthen tenure security for both urban and rural poor



# Priority areas of activity identified by GLTN Partners

- Urban-rural continuum land policy activities
- Strategic urban-rural land use planning
- Urban-rural spatial data infrastructure and land information sharing
- Continuum approaches for land tenure and food security
- Important cross-cutting urban-rural development activities
