## FIG in Vietnam

FIG's 7th regional conference Spatial Data Serving People: Land Governance and the Environment - Building the Capacity was held in Hanoi, Vietnam in October 2009. Over 450 delegates from 40 different countries attended to take part in over 40 technical sessions and hear almost 200 papers and presentations.

The conference was organised locally by the Vietnam Association of Geodesy, Cartography and Remote Sensing, with additional meetings organised by the UN's Food and Agriculture Organisation. ICES vice president Gethin Roberts attended as the institution's delegate for commissions 5 and 6, which cover positioning and engineering surveys. Over the course of the week, the commissions covered:

- Disaster risk management.
- Mapping, aerial survey and remote sensing.
- Asia Pacific Reference Frame.
- Engineering applications of GNSS and standards.
- Advances in GNSS positioning.
- · Coastal zone issues.
- Sensors and data processing.
- · Environmental monitoring and protection.
