ABSTRACT

As stated in the Bathurst declaration it is essential for every country to have a sound and trustworthy cadastral system, in which valuation plays an important role as a tool to provide society with information's about accumulation of wealth.

It is not the wealth itself that is of greatest importance but the change of wealth combined with the goals for the financial situation set up by the politicians.

To provide this information different valuation systems are set up on the basis on different legal systems. The information's are collected in different ways and the policies about spreading out these informations to the owners as well as the public is subject to discussions and vary even in countries with similar systems.
