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Conclusions and Recommendations

- No teacher or supervisor will ever be perfect, but there are ways to improve the quality of learning
- The attitudes of teacher and student are more important than any recommended teaching method
- Students learn by experience but they learn more by thinking about what they are doing
- Students can learn from their mistakes, if they are aware of it and know how to avoid it, or how to do better next time. A teacher, or surveyor in a supervisor role, can assist with that.
