3.3 Special Dictionary Commission – Eng. Daniel Acuña, Coordinator

The commission proposed creation of a repository of terms related to the different themes of Surveying, Topography, Geodesy, Geomatics and the like. The proposal is to develop a digital platform where information can be fed in the following way:

May 16, 2020 - First APPAT International Virtual Congress

Webinars to be held:

June 26, 2021 – International Day of Women in Engineering Forum.
