Land Governance

A. Good land stewardshipB. Efficient land useC. Equitable land use

Typically a line ministry

Not defined spatially or economically



Land Management

- Process oriented
- Administration of powers
- Efficiency in local use priorities
- Records
- Dispute resolution
- May be spatially or economically defined



Governance + management

- Governance must shape management
- Management should inform governance
- Management should not be a substitute for governance

Principles and objectives should be in common even as means of achieving them may vary





E.g. Peri-urban development

- Neither urban nor rural
- Major contest between spatial, economic and cultural priorities
- Requires an outcome oriented framework

If the governance framework is clear, local management is more effective



GLTN in the Urban-Rural Continuum

- Support land interventions in both urban and rural contexts
- Promote the continuum of land rights approach and Fit-for-Purpose Land Administration
- Strong network of both urban and rural land actors
- Develop and implement specific land tools to strengthen tenure security for both urban and rural poor

- Strategic urban-rural land use planning
- Urban-rural spatial data infrastructure and land information sharing
- Continuum approaches for land tenure and food security


