

## **Institution of Surveyors of Uganda invites FIG members to week-long professional events in Gulu City**

The Institution of Surveyors of Uganda (ISU), a FIG Member Association, has announced a week-long programme of professional and celebratory activities to be held in Gulu City, Northern Uganda, from **Monday 16 March to Saturday 21 March 2026**.

ISU is Uganda's premier professional body for surveying and related disciplines, bringing together more than 2,500 professionals and students in land surveying, quantity surveying, valuation surveying, mining and hydrological surveying. The Institution operates under the mandate of the Surveyors' Registration Act of 1974 and plays a central role in promoting professional standards, continuous professional development (CPD) and the general welfare of surveyors in Uganda.

In line with its commitment to professional learning, capacity building and member well-being, ISU regularly organises conferences, trainings, as well as technical and social visits. Building on this mandate, the Institution has now organised a series of flagship annual events, including the 10th ISU Pre-AGM Conference, Global Surveyors' Day and Week celebrations, and the 35th ISU Annual General Meeting (AGM).

The events will take place under the theme:

**“Biodiversity Conservation and Restoration: Land, Water and Construction Professionals’ Role in Conserving for the Present and Future Generations.”**

Gulu City, located approximately 330 kilometres north of Uganda's capital, Kampala, will host a programme combining professional dialogue with technical and social tours, as well as Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities, as detailed in the official programme.

ISU has invited FIG Member Associations worldwide to take part in the events and engage with the Ugandan surveying community. The conference participation fee is USD 150 per delegate, and early confirmation of participation is encouraged, preferably before mid-February 2026, to support planning and logistics.

Following the Uganda events, participants will be well placed to continue onward to the FIG Working Week in Cape Town, South Africa.
