The primary goal is to work with FIG to exchange advanced surveying knowledge in order to acquire knowledge on how advance technologies can be exploited to strengthen the cadaster in order to ensure tenure security to all.

NICS- Committed Host and Member Association: NICS is committed to conducting FIG Working week 2027 to deliver a conference that creates opportunity to showcase the professional competency of the Surveying Community in Nepal.

Host City- Kathmandu: Endless Exploration opportunities for Surveyors: Nepal is the safe country and rated 2nd on the 2021 Global Peace Index in south Asia. Kathmandu, the capital ciy of Nepal, is a vibrant and bustling metropolis, is a cultural melting pot with several UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Kathmandu Valley is itself a museum of temples, traditions and tourism.

Suggested Theme: SURVEYORS TO STRENGTHEN CADASTER: ensuring tenure security for all!

Suggested Dates: The weeks of April 18-24; April 25-May 1; and May 2- May 8 are the potential dates for the event. Out of which April 18-24 is considered to be the most potential date.

Suggested Venue: Hotel Soaltee Limited, Hyatt Regency Kathmandu and Kathmandu University Campus are the three possible venues for the event

Past Events: As a professional partner, NICS has been actively organizing various national and international events. Three international events have been organized since 2015.

Strong Impact We are committed to leave an indelible mark from hosting FIG, by exchanging experiences from the developed world that we believe helps in reshaping our professional domain. Hosting FIG can help to showcase Nepal's potential as a hub for innovation and growth that can increase new investments and partnerships with international organizations that can lead to economic growth and development in surveying profession. Also, FIG can increase its visibility to collaborate with developing countries in order to solve significant development challenges like rapid urbanization, natural disasters.

Financial Feasibility and support: Hosting this event is supported by the Government of Nepal, different government organizations, academic institutions, and international professional organizations. Estimates of income is based on the experiences from the past FIG events. Therefore, NICS is confident about the financial feasibility for the event.

Air Access and Transport: Tribhuvan International Airport connects the hosting City that is Kathmandu currently allowing about 29 international airlines. There are 13 direct flights from the area's international airport to the majority of Asian nation and Istanbul.

Affordable and Accessible accommodation: Hotels abound both inside and outside of Kathmandu. There are approximately 8 fivestar hotels close to the proposed location for the start of the FIG working week in 2027. The price ranges from US\$ 150 and so accommodation facilities for the students or young surveyors can be arranged around US\$50.

Reasonable meals and beverages The city of Kathmandu, offers a wide variety of cuisines, from regional street food to international eateries. The cost per dish can range from (USD 1 to 15). Similar to that, Nepali beverages range in price from USD 1 to 4 per bottle and include both soft drinks and hard liquor.




Initiatives for sustainable conference environment



(1) Soaltee Hotel Limited


Visit to Tourist Center in Kathmandu:

As mentioned earlier, Kathmandu Valley is a museum of temples, tradition and tourism. Main touristic



Hiking in Shivapuri National park:

Hiking- One-half day(around 8 hours)-Shivapuri National Park is a protected area located in the northern part of Kathmandu Valley in Nepal. The park is a popular destination for hiking, trekking, and wildlife viewing. It is home to a diverse range of flora and fauna, including over 300 species of birds, 19 species of mammals, and numerous species of reptiles, amphibians, and butterflies. The park also has several cultural and religious sites, such as the Shivapuri Baba Ashram, Nagi Gompa, and the Kali Temple. destinations are within the range of 5 to15 kilometers from the venue. Major touristic destinations can be Pashupatinath, Swayambhu, Bouddha, Chandragiri hill, Darbar square from Kathmandu, Bhaktapur and Lalitpur, Krishna Mandir among others.





Mountain flights to Himalayan range

Spring season considered to be the best season for mountain flights from Kathmandu. The mountain

flights are done along the Himalayan range of Mt. Everest. It costs around \in 300 for a flight of about one hour. Participant of the event can make this adventurous journey during any of the morning of the event. Prior booking will be advised to make sure that flights are available during the event period.



Technical tour and Site Seen to Nagarkot

Nagarkot is a small village located about 32 kilometers east of Kathmandu, Nepal's capital city. It is situated at an elevation of 2,195 meters above sea level and is known for its stunning panoramic views of the Himalayan range, including Mount Everest, as well as the beautiful sunrise and sunset. This place also hosts Geodetic Observatory and the base trigonometrical point of



Nepal along with astronomical research facility. The observatory is operated by the Survey Department of Nepal and is responsible for monitoring the tectonic activity and the deformation of the earth's crust in Nepal.



Technical Tour and Site Seen to Dhulikhel



Technical Tour to the Dhulikehl includes short visit to Kathmandu University, one of the top universities, started bachelors in Geomatics engineering, first time in south asia back in 2007 and Land Management Training Center(LMTC), a government training institution, provides training to the government officials related to surveying and mapping. At the same time, visitors can enjoy the scenic beauty of the city. This city also offers zipline adventure as well as a visit to ancient city with unique culture.

Tour out of valley.

Following three destinations are advised to the visitor, but a week long extension will be required. (a) Safari in Chitwan National Park

Chitwan national park is in a distance of 150 kilometers from Kathmandu. It takes 5-6 hours of car drive

or 15 minutes of flight. National park offers diverse species of wild life. This park is famous for One horn rhinos. Safari can be done via car or elephant.



(b) Pilgrimage to Lumbini: the birth place of lord Buddha

Lumbini- the birth place of lord Buddha is about 150 kilometers from Chitwan National park. A pilgrimage can be made for the next day of safari at Chitwan





(c) Visits to Pokhara- touristic city

Pokhara is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Nepal. It



of the few places on earth from where mountains above 6,000 m can be seen unobstructed from an altitude of 800 m within the distance of 28 km. Furthermore, Pokhara is also known as city of lakes and caves, and famous for boating, trekking, rafting, paragliding,

is about 200 kilometers from Kathmandu. It can also be made from Lumbini in a day. The valley is best known for the stunning view of the Annapurna Himalayan range. It is perhaps one

Accommodations

Kathmandu has a number of international class hotels to suit every one's fancies and finance. The other hotels are Hotel Dwarikas, Summit Hotel, Shanker Hotel, etc. The students and surveyors find affordable voung can accommodation in the proximity of the venue. The prices of 5-star hotels ranges from US\$150 and above, where as affordable hotels for the students can be found in the range of US\$ 50.

The city of Kathmandu, which is rich in Newari culture, offers a wide variety of cuisines, from regional street food to international eateries. The cost per dish can range from (USD 1 to 15). Similar to that, Nepali beverages range in price from USD 1 to 4 per bottle and include both soft drinks and hard liquor.

Local street food: You can find various local street food options in Kathmandu, such as

omos, samosas, and chow mein, for around NPR 100-300 (USD 1-3) per dish.

Local restaurants: Local restaurants in Kathmandu offer traditional Nepali dishes such as dal bhat (rice and lentil soup with vegetables) and thukpa (noodle soup) for around NPR 300-600 (USD 3-6) per meal.

International restaurants: There are also many international restaurants in Kathmandu that offer cuisines such as Chinese, Indian, Italian, and Continental. Prices for meals in these restaurants can range from NPR 600-1,500 (USD 6-15) per dish.

Beverages: Soft drinks, such as Coca-Cola and Pepsi, are widely available in Kathmandu and cost around NPR 50-100 (USD 0.5-1) per can or bottle. Local beer, such as Everest, Gorkha, and Nepal Ice, can be found for around NPR 200-400 (USD 2-4) per bottle. Imported beers and wines are also available in some restaurants and bars at higher prices.



Financial Feasibility and Support

Detailed estimate of income and expenditure has been included in Annex 1. Estimation of income are based on the past experiences from FIG events. The sources of income are generally based on the registration fees and sponsorships. We have expected a support of €50,000.00, in cash and/or kind, from the Government of Nepal. We believe, our good wishers, development partners and supporting organizations help us meeting the estimated income for the event. The cost of item required for the event are mostly based on current market value in Kathmandu. Best efforts will be made to economies the expenses. NICS is confident that the management will not face any sort of income.

Tribhuvan International Airport is the closest international airport to the venue. It is in the distance of about 6 kilometers from the center of Kathmandu Valley and within the distance of 10 kilometers from the possible venue of the event. The other two recently opened international airports are more than 200 kilometers from the venue. So, the participants are advised to use the flight to Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu.

At present, about 29 international airlines connect Nepal to various other destinations in different part

of the world. There are direct flights to Turkey and major Asian cities like Delhi, Mumbai, Dhaka, Hongkong, Shanghai, Seoul, Singapore, Tokyo, Dubai, Doha, Sharjah and Abu Dhabi. The Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal is also working on the expansion of the air network to the other part of the world and we believe by the time of



event, we will have connections to major European cities.

There will be pick-up and drop-off service from and to the airport, given the itinerary informed in advance.

Visa- Information and Assistance

Nepal is one of the most easily accessible country in the world. One can obtain visa, except nationals of few countries, upon arrival at the international airport. Immigration Office, under Department of Immigration, at the international airport facilitates the Visa on Arrival. 'On Arrival' visa procedure is very quick and simple but during peak touristic seasons a long queue might have to be faced. Visitors can also consider getting Visa from Nepalese Diplomatic Missions stationed abroad prior to their arrival. A visitor need to enter Nepal within six months from the visa issued date and his/her total stay is counted from the day he/she enters into Nepal.

Indian nationals do not need visa, an ID with photograph is sufficient. Nationals of Nigeria, Ghana, Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Cameroon, Somalia, Liberia, Ethiopia, Iraq, Palestine, Afghanistan, Syria, and Refugees with travel document are requested to acquire Visa prior their arrival from their nearby Diplomatic missions (Embassies/consulates) of Nepal Government. Nationals of the rest of the countries around the globe can get visa on arrival.

It costs US\$ 30 for 15 days of stay in Nepal, which would be sufficient not only to make the event but also explore Nepal for rest of the days. Organizing committee will issue recommendation letters to the Department of Immigration of the Government of Nepal to ease the visa processing for the participants of the event, and the committee will also request the Department to have special desk at the immigration for the FIG participants.




