Confirmation

Participants will receive a confirmation email from fig@fig.net after the purchase of the conference registration. An invoice of the purchased will be included in the confirmation email. Print a copy of your confirmation to be shown at the conference Registration Desk. Participation is not guaranteed until full payment of the registration fee is received.

Modification or additional tickets

If you wish to modify or purchase additional tickets (Pre- or Post events, Dutch evening, Gala Dinner, technical or social tours), please contact the [FIG Office](#). Please note: all these events have limited availability. Places will be given away on a first-paid basis.

Substitution

If you are unable to attend, you are welcome to nominate someone else to attend in your place at no additional cost. Please advise substitutions by writing to [FIG Office](#). Please note: Any substitution that is not communicated in writing will not be considered valid. The financial aspect has to be handled between the registered individual who is not attending and the individual who is substituting.

Cancellation policy and refunds

Refunds will take place within 30 days of receiving the completed cancellation form. The conference is not responsible for the potential differences in the exchange rate. This cost has to be borne by the buyer. If payment has already been made, credit card disputes cannot be used to obtain a refund. In order to receive a refund, you have to follow the procedure described above.

In the event that the conference is cancelled by the FIG 2020 Organizing Committee, or by any reason or any factor out of the control of the Organizing Committee, such as force majeure, natural disasters, weather conditions, acts of terrorism, or by any other cause beyond the control of the FIG 2020 Organizing Committee, which results in the 2020 FIG Working Week cannot take place; the FIG 2020 Organizing Committee will try to make all possible to reschedule the FIG Working Week. In such cases, it is entirely the decision of the local FIG 2020 Organizing Committee to decide on the refunds of the Registration Fee. The liability of the Organizers shall be limited to the refund and they shall not be liable for any other loss, cost or expense, however caused, incurred or arising. In particular, the FIG 2020 Organizers shall not be liable to refund any travel or hotel costs incurred by delegates or their organizations. It follows that delegates and accompanying partners are advised to take out comprehensive insurance, including travel insurance.

Any collection costs incurred will be the responsibility of the debtor.
