EFFECTS OF COVID-19

Covid has had a devastating impact on the Survey profession in South Africa.

- We already had a weak economy and then had a hard lockdown including a full business closure for some time.
- The effects are different across different age demographics of the profession:
 - Those close to retirement, brought such forward or reduced operations to consulting to clients from home - no intention of upscaling again.
 - Well established practitioners downsized (staff and in many cases offices).
 - Younger professionals financially forced to close business (lack of wide client base to sustain their practices).

Overall: High unemployment of surveyors, few jobs available, new work (contracts / projects) not sufficient for the market.
