2022 to 2032








THE SITUATION ACROSS AUSTRALIA

Current total workforce is around 19,000 persons – 15,000 surveying and geospatial professionals and 4,000 allied professionals.

East Coast accounts for 72% of the total skilled surveying and geospatial professionals





National capability shortfall over the next 10 years

A shortfall of surveying and geospatial professionals means a significant increase needed in education

 940 new university students needed each year, an increase of 170%

 517 new vocational education students needed each year, an increase of 167% National capability shortfall over the next 10 years

- Quality education and skills connected to the profession with a standard that meets the industry needs














Why the Academy?
