Land Law:

State public, State private and private land

Constitution:

Private Property-oriented

Sub-Decree:

No. 118: State Land Management



Art. 44 Cambodian Constitution

"All persons, individually or collectively, shall have the rights to own property. (…)

Legal private ownership shall be protected by law.

Expropriation (...) shall be exercised only in the public interest as provided for by law (...)."

Land reform approaches

- Skim off the ground rent completely
- Redistribute the ground rent into the hand of the local communities

 Ensure better and secure access to land without high acquisition costs

 Make spatial planning neutral – make it bare of ground rent
