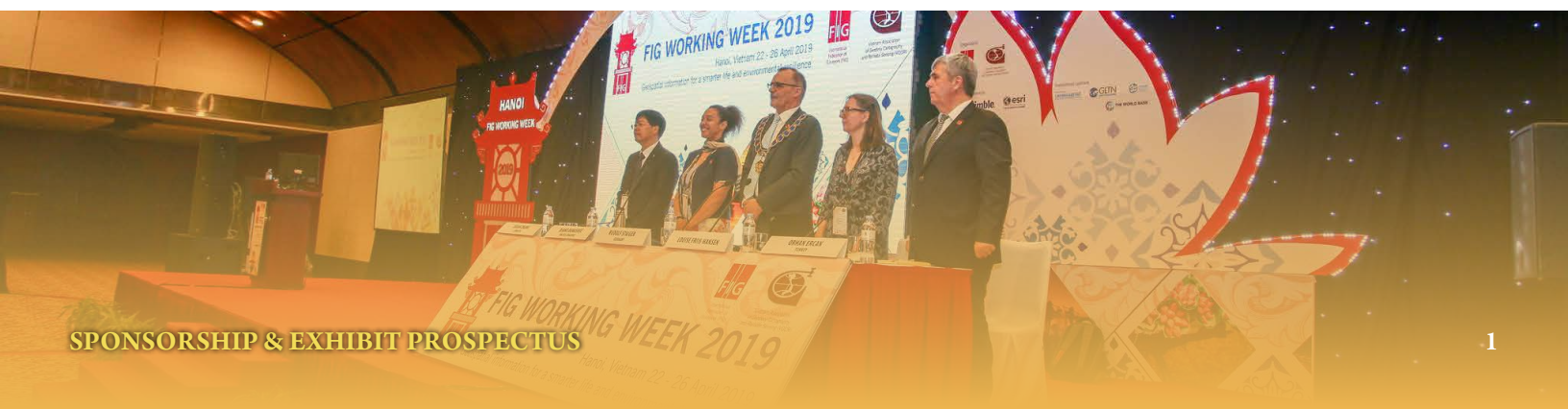




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The FIG Working Week 2023 Program and the FIG Commissions

The 10 technical commissions of FIG are responsible for the program content of the FIG Working Week. These 10 commissions cover all disciplines of the surveying and geospatial profession, including: Surveying (Aerial / Archaeological / Astronomical / Cadastral / Engineering / Environmental / Forensic / Geodetic / Geological / Hydrographic / Military / Mining / Party Wall / Quantity / Topographic), Appraisal, BIM, Education, GIS, Photogrammetry, Real Estate, Remote Sensing, Standards.

Commission 1—Professional Standards and Practice

Commission 1 focuses on establishing a set of ethical principles that fits the surveying profession for reference by professional institutions. It also focuses on promoting greater understanding and improving community perceptions about the surveying profession

Commission 2—Professional Education

The focus of Commission 2 is on innovative and effective professional education and training for surveyors.

Commission 3—Spatial Information Management

Commission 3 has the task of providing an international discussion and development forum to promote professional practice and standards in the field of Spatial Information Management.

Commission 4—Hydrography

Commission 4 is focusing on development and recognition of standards of competency, development of technical standards and guidelines, developing and promoting the need to manage our oceans and seas in a sustainable manner, and a comprehensive investigation of plastic pollution at source that is concerning global environmental problem (“Mapping the Plastic”).

Commission 5—Positioning and Measurement

Commission 5 focuses on meeting the highest level of accuracy for Positioning and Measurement. It provides tools, techniques, and procedures to educate and train surveying professionals everywhere. Appropriate methodology for data collection and processing are required to be successful in an era of global, integrated geospatial data.



The FIG Working Week 2023 Program and the FIG Commissions *Continued*

Commission 6—Engineering Surveys

Commission 6, Engineering Surveys, deals with the production of data on the geometry and location, from large structures to small objects, either man-made or natural.

Commission 7—Cadastre and Land Management

Commission 7 is focusing on providing a discussion platform for ideas and tools to improve land tenure security around the world.

Commission 8—Spatial Planning and Development

Commission 8 recognizes land is a scarce resource. In pursue of a sustainable development, it is key to balance the various, sometimes conflicting, interests in spatial planning and to acknowledge the voice of all stakeholders. Themes addressed are urban challenges, urban-rural dependencies, and GIS and land policy tools for implementation.

Commission 9—Valuation and the Management of Real Estate

Commission 9 is focusing on the economic strand of surveying and specifically the valuation/appraisal of real estate.

Commission 9 is also engaged with numerous agencies such as World Bank, UN FAO, GLTN, and IFC.

Commission 10—Construction Economics and Management

Commission 10 is focusing upon collaborative international standards in this discipline (ICMS), digital construction (incl. BIM) and differing approaches to the financial management of construction around the world.

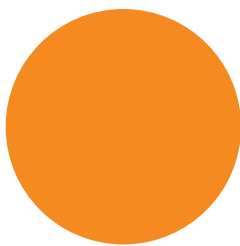

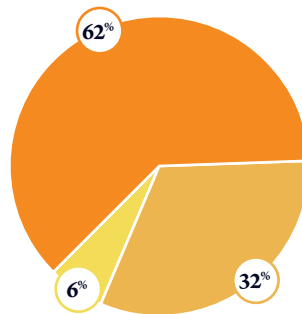

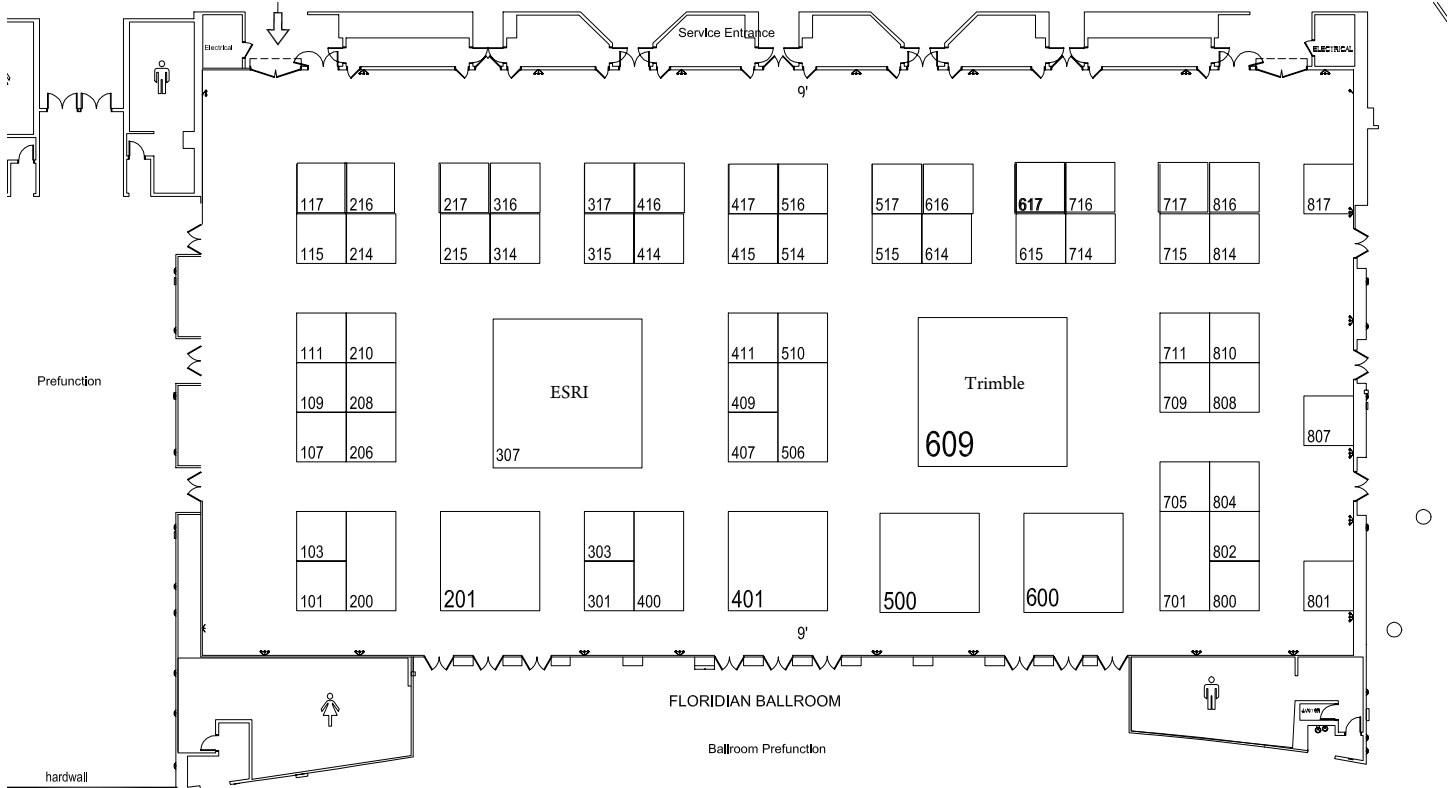

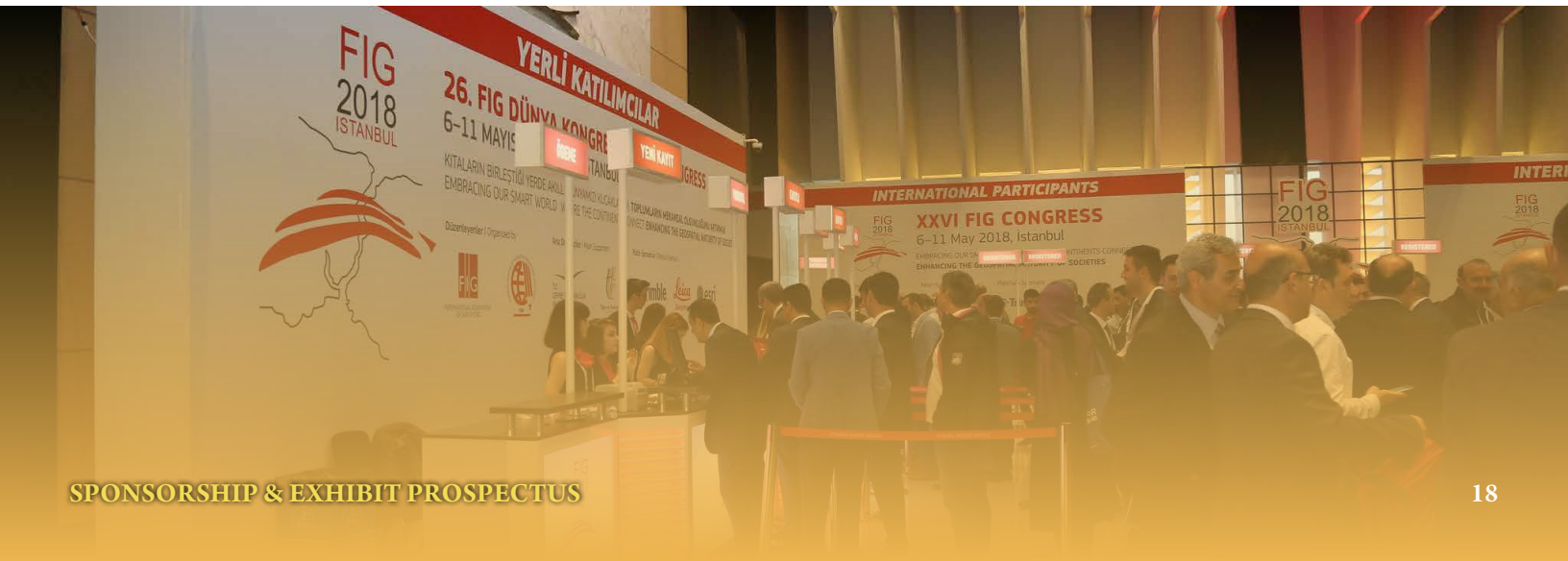

International Federation
of Surveyors

FIG is the premier international organization representing the interests of surveyors worldwide. It is a federation of the national member associations and covers the whole range of professional fields within the global surveying, geomatics, geodesy and geo-information community. It provides an international forum for discussion and development aiming to promote professional practice and standards.

FIG was founded on July 18, 1878 in Paris by delegates from seven national associations - Belgium, France, Germany, Great Britain, Italy, Spain and Switzerland - and was known as the *Fédération Internationale des Géomètres*. This has become anglicized to the International Federation of Surveyors.
