





It consisted of Professor Abbas Rajabifard, Dr. Daniel Steudler, and Professor Ian Williamson, supported by Professor Stig Enemark from Aalborg University, Denmark. PCGIAP-Working Group 3 "Cadastre" cooperates with FIG-Commission 7 to place the country information jointly on this website and to maintain the information during its 2003-2006 Work Plan.

Background

- Motivation: there is a need for FIG to look into
 - i. its knowledge assets and underlying infrastructure;
 - ii. work towards an operational strategy on how to hold and disseminate this knowledge; and
 - iii. formalize any policy around this body of knowledge (internally and externally)
- Existing body of knowledge: **OICRF / Conference proceedings / Cadastral Template**
- Further information collections: FIG Surveyors Reference Library / FIG Publications (also in cooperation with partner organizations) / FIG Peer Review Journal / FIG Databases / Articles about FIG / Articles of the Month / Newsletters

Main Objectives

- identify the concerned knowledge bases, as well as potential overlaps and possible synergies;
- develop a policy of how FIG handles and disseminates these knowledge bases;
- define who and what the (co-)ownerships, cooperation, and responsibilities over these knowledge bases are while also considering future options;
- improve the visibility of the knowledge bases in order to underline the FIGs strategic status.

Considerations

- different operational options:
→ centralized management / → mixed management solution / → decentralized management
- how can FIG make the knowledge bases better visible and accessible through its communication channels (web, newsletter, etc.)
- resource-saving / clear definition of responsibilities / distinction between technical infrastructure and expertise / fit for future use (digital world)
