

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

I. INTRODUCTION

Under this MOU, the Stand for Her Land Campaign (hereinafter "S4HL") and International Federation of Surveyors (hereinafter "FIG") agree to work together to:

- 1. Support understanding of S4HL and issues related to women's land rights generally among FIG leadership and members.
- 2. Support connections and collaborative efforts between FIG leadership and members and the S4HL Steering Committee and stakeholders to achieve mutually agreeable outcomes.
- 3. Jointly promote the work of S4HL and FIG, including by displaying logos on respective websites to indicate support, and other activities as feasible and desirable (e.g., blogs, webinars, workshops).

The Rural Development Institute dba Landesa serves as the Secretariat for the S4HL, performing strategic, administrative, financial, and fundraising leadership functions, and facilitating the S4HL Steering Committee. In this role, Landesa will serve as the point of contact and primary institutional actor for this MOU, in close collaboration with Steering Committee members. Landesa will keep FIG apprised of any changes to this arrangement (e.g., should S4HL become its own legal entity).

III. EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS MOU

This MOU shall come into force and effect on **January 1, 2022**, and shall expire on **December 31, 2030**, to include an interim review every 2 years. The MOU may be extended by written agreement of the Parties. Each Party may terminate the MOU in advance of its expiration date by providing thirty (30) days' notice to the other Party in writing.

IV. ACTIVITIES UNDER THIS MOU

S4HL and FIG will work collaboratively to:

- 1. Support understanding of S4HL and issues related to women's land rights generally among FIG leadership and members.
- 2. Support connections and collaborative efforts between FIG leadership and members and the S4HL Steering Committee and stakeholders to achieve mutually agreeable outcomes.
- 3. Jointly promote the work of S4HL and FIG, including by displaying logos on respective websites to indicate support, and other activities as feasible and desirable (e.g., blogs, webinars, workshops).

V. TREATMENT OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Except as expressly agreed in writing, the Parties agree not to disclose to anyone confidential information that might be acquired from one another during the performance of this MOU including, but not limited to, business



trade secrets or proprietary or privileged information, whether or not such information is labeled as such ("Confidential Information"). Each Party agrees to protect such Confidential Information at a level no less protective than accorded its own Confidential Information, which at a minimum strictly limits disclosures of the Confidential Information, if any, to the Party's employees, consultants, and other third parties who require access to the Confidential Information in connection with performance of work on a need-to-know basis only.

VI. PAYMENT UNDER THIS MOU

Each Party shall bear its own costs in fulfillment of the activities under this MOU.
