Final Progress Report of the FIG Council Work Plan 2007-2010 approved at the Council Meeting in Copenhagen 25 November 2010




FIG Council meeting in Copenhagen in November 2010

The final progress report will be brought to the General Assembly for its approval in Marrakech in May 2011. At this last meeting of the FIG Council 2007-2010 the Council approved Survey Department from Sri Lanka as an affiliate member, the East Kazakhstan State Technical University named after D. Serikbayev as an academic member and Danos S.A. from Greece as a new corporate member.
