Article of the Month

Each month on the FIG web site we publish a paper called the Article of the Month. This is a high-level paper focusing on interesting topics to all surveyors. It can be picked up from a FIG conference or another event.

The Article of the Month in March 2014 is written by Alexander Kohli, Switzerland:

Adjusting Laws to meet the Requirements of Urban Expansion in a Sustainable Property System. The paper of the month presents a concept for Sustainable Land Management to secure a long term successful development of informal urbanization. To create good conditions for improving the property and planning situation, a solid legal base has to be put in place before further land management activities are undertaken. The author asks for the initialization of an intermediate legal frame-work as an initial step to be applied to a special perimeter of action, the so-called 'temporary development zones' TDZ. Wednesday 18 June 9:00: The Profession has key roles towards the betterment of society, environment and economy and need to attend to emerging issues and trends.


Thursday 19 June 9:00: The Profession has key roles towards the betterment of society, environment and economy and must continue its march to the top, towards professional significance and relevance.



New Joint FIG/World Bank Publication - FIG Guide - Fit-For-Purpose Land Administration, publication no 60



This publication is the result of cooperation between the World Bank and the International Federation of Surveyors (FIG) over recent years to address the issue of building and sustaining land administration systems that are basically fit-for-purpose rather than blindly complying with top-end technological solutions and rigid regulations for accuracy. The cooperation started by the joint FIG / World Bank conference in 2009 addressing "Land Governance in Support of the Millennium Development Goals". The concept of "fit-for-purpose" emerged from various events indicating that land administration should be designed to meet the needs of people and their relationship to land, to support security of tenure for all and to sustainably manage land use and natural resources. The publication was launched at the World Bank Conference.
