EFFECTS OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1st Lockdown

(17 March-11 May 2020)

Most personal and business travel prohibited,
with the exception of a few rare sectors of economic activity

Generalization of telework in surveying firms and at OGE



From May 2020, **gradual recovery of economic activity** was operated

OGE issued **guidelines and manuals** for the **resumption of surveyors' activities in the field**

OGE launched a **survey campaign** to question the profession on the **economic impact of the crisis** on the activity of firms



These provisions prevailed in continuation during the 2 following lockdowns (Nov-Dec 2020 and Feb-May 2021) and the periods in between

Fortunately no collapse in activity for the surveying sector, so far



WOMEN IN SURVEYING - PROMOTING YOUNGSTER'S



14% of the 1,869 French licensed surveyors are women
in 2020 (11% in 2015)

, **25% of new members** registered in 2019 **were women**

OGE has been a partner of the Equality Laboratory since 2015
An "**Equality and Diversity**" **Commission** has thus been
created within the OGE in 2015.

OGE is committed to **equal representation** of genders when
speaking in the media or in any public speaking



Since 2017 many actions are conducted
to promote the profession to young audiences and to
strengthen its attractiveness to students in vocational
training channels

Development of an **employer brand**

Revision of the professional texts for a **diversification of the profiles** to join the profession (lawyers, urban planners...)

Creation in 2012 of the **status of salaried surveyor**
(2/3 of new entrants)
